Do they **bruise easier** than normal?

Bruising easily is one of the signs of MDS – myelodysplastic syndromes, a group of rare blood cancers.

Low blood counts can result in patients reporting:

- Excessive bruising following minor injuries
- Nosebleeds
- Gum bleeds
- Pinpoint-sized red spots under the skin
