Do they have more **fatigue** than usual?

Fatigue is one of the signs of MDS – myelodysplastic syndromes, a group of rare blood cancers.

Fatigue, caused by anaemia, can result in patients reporting:

- **Excessive tiredness**
- **Lack of energy**
- **Muscle weakness**
